#### 1. Invitation of Applications:-

Online applications are invited for direct recruitment of 700 Temporary posts of Constable(Executive) of Group C in the pay scale of Central Pay Level-3 (Revised) as per 7th CPC plus allowances through URL mentioned on the website of Chandigarh Police i.e. http://chandigarhpolice.gov.in from 27.05.2023 to 17.06.2023 till 11:59 P.M. Thereafter website link will be disabled.

#### 2. **Details of Posts:-**

3. Eligibility Standards for these posts are as under:-

#### (i) Age as on 20.05.2023:

18-25 years (General Category) 18-28 years (OBC Category) 18-30 years (SC Category)

#### Age Relaxation:-

- a) Relaxable up to the maximum age of 45 years for Ex-servicemen as on the cut-off date prescribed for the recruitment i.e. 20.05.2023
- b) Upto seven years relaxation for Chandigarh Home Guard Volunteers provided they are working/on roll continuously for the last 2 years or more, as on 20.05.2023, as under:i)
  - 2 years relaxation for those with a service of 2 years.
  - 3 years relaxation for those with a service of 3 years. ii)
  - iii) 4 years relaxation for those with a service of 4 years.

- iv) 5 years relaxation for those with a service of 5 years.
- v) 6 years relaxation for those with a service of 6 years.
- vi) 7 years relaxation for those with a service of 7 years.
- c) Relaxation for wards of working or retired or deceased (except dismissed, compulsory retired or removed from service) Chandigarh Police employees as under:
  - i) 2 years relaxation for wards of Serving and retired (living or deceased) employees
  - ii) 3 years relaxation for wards of those who died in service

d) Departmental candidates of Chandigarh Police upto 40 years as on 20.5.2023

(ii) Minimum Educational Qualification: 10+2 or equivalent

\*For Ex-Servicemen, 10+2 or Certificates awarded in the Defence Services which are recognised as equivalent to 10+2

## (iii) Driving Skills:-

Possession of a valid driving license to drive both, two-wheelers and four-wheel vehicles, is mandatory for male candidates of all categories as on the date of submission of online application.

#### (iv) <u>Computer Skills:-</u>

Candidates should have basic knowledge of computer skills from any recognized institute in line of GOI/MHA No. 25019/01/2018-PM-II dated 5<sup>th</sup> November 2018 and Chandigarh Administration Home Department No. 10385-HIII (1) 2018/23703 Dated 14.11.2018.

#### 5. Criteria for Selection, Examination & Syllabus:-

5.1. <u>Written Test</u>: - All candidates (including ex-servicemen) shall be put through a OMR Sheet-based written test which shall carry 100 marks. The questions shall be multiple choice objective types and will carry one mark for every correct answer and a negative marking of 0.25 for every wrong answer. The question paper for the Written Test shall be in Hindi, English and Punjabi. Each candidate will be given the test paper only in the language selected by the candidate during the application process. Change of medium will not be permitted.

#### 5.2 Cut off marks for written test/CBT/OMR:-

The minimum qualifying cut-off marks in the written exam/CBT/OMR for each category shall be as follows:-

## Physical Efficiency & Measurement Test (PE&MT):-

The first measurement of a candidate would be his/her height and chest. Candidates not fulfilling the height and chest criteria would be rejected forthwith. Only candidates fulfilling these criteria would be allowed to proceed further in PE&MT as per following criteria:-

\*Wards of Police Personnel can avail only one relaxation, either of height or of chest in addition to the relaxation in age. Such relaxation shall be admissible to a limit of two children for any police personnel household.

All candidates shall be subjected to a dope test before PE&MT.

## 7. General Instructions / Guidelines for Online Filling of Application Form

- a. Apply online well in advance without waiting for last date of submission of online application form.
- b. Please read the instructions and procedures carefully before you start filling the Online Application Form and check all the particulars filled up in application form to ensure the correctness of information.
- c. The candidate should fill all details while filling the Online Application Form. After applying online, Application number and Password will be generated and sent through email. Take print out of the Application no. and password screen for future reference of your application status.
- d. The final submission of Application form will only be after payment of the fee through Recruitment Portal.
- e. Candidate shall be considered only against the category against which he had applied. Any change of category after submission of application form shall not be permitted.
- f. No request for change of any particular field on the application form shall be entertained by the Department, after final submission of application.
- g. No offline application form or copy of downloaded application form will be accepted by the Chandigarh Police Department.
- h. Candidates who do not fulfill the qualifications/eligibility conditions on cutoff date for recruitment, their application shall not be accepted by the online application system. All the Certificates relating to educational qualification/eligibility conditions, etc. will be determined with regard to cut off date for recruitment i.e. **20.05.2023**, unless otherwise specified.
- i. Incomplete form in any respect shall be summarily rejected.
- j. The decision of the Recruitment Board in all matters relating to acceptance or rejection of an application, eligibility/suitability of the candidates, mode and criteria for selection etc. will be final and binding on the candidates. No inquiry or correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- k. If on verification at any stage starting from submitting application form till appointment, it is found that any candidate does not fulfill any of the eligibility condition or it is found that the information furnished is false or incorrect, his/her candidature will be cancelled and he/she will also be liable to be criminally prosecuted. This is irrespective of whether the candidate was benefitted by furnishing the false or incorrect information in his/ her application. Even after appointment at any later stage if it is found that any information furnished by any candidate is incorrect, he/she shall be liable to be prosecuted legally.
- 1. The Department reserves the right to call upon any candidate personally along with printed copy of the application form with original certificates and photocopy of self-attested certificates along with Photo, Identity Proof i.e. identity Card/ Driving License/ Passport/Voter Card/Pan Card/Aadhaar Card etc. at any stage of the Recruitment.
